2015 has been an amazing year of accomplishments and growth as an organization while continuing to champion projects that help impoverished communities become self-reliant.



In Kenya, school uniforms are compulsory for all public schools. School uniform is intended to serve two purposes – to instill a sense of belonging and pride in the school and to eliminate competition in personal dress

The Problem

For families' facing the challenge of poverty in Kenya, school clothes are not as crucial as the next meal but they are important. The combined costs of education, uniform, shoes, books and supplies, force hundreds of vulnerable children to miss out on school each year. For a child in need from a poor rural family who may own only one pair of old pants or a tattered dress, a school uniform is not just a requirement but essential to building confidence and academic success.

Solution

Your donation and/or purchase of school uniform will provide school clothing and shoes for an orphan or vulnerable child at Jamii School, helping them get an education which can make the difference between a life of poverty and a life of opportunity.
