This past August, our team of 23 experienced a whirlwind of activity as we dedicated both our KIZIMANI Mission Clinic in Kangundo and the newly rebuilt Jamii school in Eldoret. We held two free medical clinics that served over 1,400 people, delivered food and supplies to over 40 families in Manyatta, Kangundo, held two pastoral training sessions, provided a bible camp to 600 Jamii students, and a healing arts camp to 40 at-risk youth at New Dawn High School. We thank all of our supporters for their generosity and prayers for what was an incredibly full two weeks.

Meet Achieng



Achieng is a forty year old single mother of four children. She was a victim of severe domestic violence before she was introduced to KIZIMANI. Due to the abuse, Achieng believed that her life was not worth living and even though she wanted to stay strong for her children, the daily pain and struggle of lack of food, home evictions and lack of tuition was overwhelming.

Through KIZIMANI family sponsorships, we were able to provide food, cover rent and pay for tuition. Two of her daughters have graduated from high school and are seeking opportunities for further education.

KIZIMANI was able to help Achieng set up a fish stall in her neighborhood market place. Her business was thriving but it came to end when the entire market went up in flames and her fish stall was burnt to the ground.

KIZIMANI is currently working with Achieng to explore another avenue of an income generating venture.
